God proved he loved the world by giving his Son.

John 3:16 KJV

[16] For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

Romans 5:8 KJV

[8] But God commendeth (demonstrates his own) his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Definition of Christ love!

John 15:13 KJV

[13] Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.

Ephesians 5:2 KJV

[2] And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.

1 John 3:16 KJV

[16] Hereby perceive we the love of God, because he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.

Jesus said it this way!

John 15:13 KJV

[13] Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.

We are almost give up on life!

Galatians 2:20-21 KJV

[20] I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by (by faith in) the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me. [21] I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.

What to do if you love God!

Galatians 5:24-25 KJV

[24] And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the (its passions) affections and lusts. [25] If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

Romans 6:6-11 KJV

[6] Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. [7] For he that is dead is freed from sin. [8] Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him: [9] Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him. [10] For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God. [11] Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Yes we all should walk, but it should be this walk!

Colossians 2:6-15 KJV

[6] As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him: [7] Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving. [8] Beware lest any man spoil (steal or using force in the time of disorder, or take you captive) you through philosophy and vain empty ) deceit, after (according to) the tradition of men, after the rudiments (basic principles) of the world, and not after (according to) Christ. [9] For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

Never confess that you don't have enough to live godly!

Colossians 1:19 KJV

[19] For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell;

Colossians 2:10

[10] And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality (rule and authority) and power: [11] In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ: [12] Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.

This should be your response when you're asked, are you sure Jesus love you!

Ephesians 1:19-23 KJV

[19] And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power, [20] Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places, [21] Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: [22] And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, [23] Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.

The new covenant by the better circumcision, than the old, which was under the law!

Colossians 2:13

[13] And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened (made alive) together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; [14] Blotting out the handwriting of

ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

Jesus gave us access to where we didn't have it before!

Ephesians 2:18 KJV

[18] For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.

There's only one way to God!

John 10:9 KJV

[9] I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.

This is what Jesus did for our breakthrough!

Colossians 2:15

[15] And having spoiled (disarmed) principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

No your enemy, this is who you're wrestling against!

Ephesians 6:12 KJV

[12] For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

This is what you need to be persuaded in!

Romans 8:38-39 KJV

[38] For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, [39] Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

When I ask is Jesus gone to heaven

1 Peter 3:22 KJV

[22] Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.

Love In action!

Hebrews 4:14-16 KJV

[14] Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession.

[15] For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. [16] Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

What Jesus says about you!

Luke 22:28 KJV

[28] Ye are they which have continued with me in my temptations. (trials)

Hebrews 2:18 KJV

[18] For in that he himself hath suffered being tempted, he is able to succour (aid) them that are tempted.

Never let when people tell you Jesus was a god so that's why he made it. Say is written in

Hebrews 4:15 KJV

[15] For we have not an high priest which cannot be (sympathize) touched with the (our weaknesses) feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.

2 Corinthians 5:21 KJV

[21] For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

Romans 1:16-17 KJV

[16] For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. [17] For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

If you go on Glory in anything glory in the Lord and what he did!

1 Corinthians 1:30-31 KJV

[30] But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: [31] That, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord.

Philippians 3:8-12 KJV

[8] Yea doubtless, and I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ, [9] And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith: [10] That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death; [11] If by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead. [12] Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus.
